### 2019/2020 Center of Excellence Award Agreement

The Center of Excellence Award is designed for high school students enrolled in approved career and technical education courses at Salina Area Technical College. SATC believes this award honors and supports a student's commitment to excellence.

This award is a partial waiver of fees and expenses\* that will apply at the end of the semester if you meet the following criteria:

- earn a C or better in every class (*NOTE: CNA students must earn a 75% or higher*)
- maintain at least 95% attendance in every class
- meet the instructor's professionalism requirements in every class

**\*Exceptions:**

- ***Diesel Technology students must purchase tools during their senior year.***
- ***Students in the programs below will only pay a small flat fee per semester as follows:***

\* CNA/CMA students are required to pay the state testing fees. The state testing fees are not refundable.

If you do not meet any one criterion, you will be charged for the full amount of program fees for the class. This is a course-by-course decision (Example: if you get a D in a course that does not mean the Center of Excellence Award is voided for all courses, only for that specific course).

Average charges per semester vary among programs and the student's individual schedule. Typical charges based upon half time enrollment per semester range from \$150 to \$400, but these amounts can vary outside of these dollar amounts. Charges are also usually higher in the first semester of enrollment. A student's anticipated semester charges can be provided prior to enrollment if requested.

Independent of the above criteria, the cost of books will be waived if they are returned in good condition. If damaged and/or not returned for any reason, you will be billed for these costs.

Additional comments:

- You or your school must pay for end-of-program third-party credentialing tests.
- Examples of 95% attendance would be missing no more than 4 classes of a 16-week course or missing no more than 2 classes of an 8-week, accelerated course. These are just examples. In the event you are taking a course that is less than 8 weeks long, 95% attendance would still apply based on the length of the course.
  - Extenuating Circumstances. If your attendance drops below 95%, you may fill out an extenuating circumstances form. A committee will review the form and may request additional documentation to validate why you missed this class. The committee decision to waive or not waive is final.
- Professionalism requirements vary by instructor, but typically they evaluate your behavior and actions. For example, how often you are tardy? Do you violate the student code of conduct? If so, how serious is the violation? Have you tried to improve? What is your ability to work in a team environment? Are your assignments late? Do you follow safety standards, etc.?
- This Award is made possible, in part, by funding of Excel in CTE Initiative. The decision to renew this award is made annually and tied to the funding of this bill.

High School Student - Payment Plan

Students enrolled in courses through Salina Tech have a couple of options for paying for college.

1. Payment Plan

To qualify for the following payment plan a student must have a minimum semester balance of \$200:
