Salina Area Technical College and **Fort Hays State University** have partnered to offer this Transfer Guide for students wishing to pursue an Associate of General Studies with the option of the Bachelor of General Studies. Students are encouraged to work with their advisor to ensure a smooth transition to FHSU. Completion of this degree prepares students to move ahead in your current job, a new career, or as a step on your way to a bachelor's degree.

Students are required to successfully finish the curriculum listed on this guide and to meet any college, university, and/or state requirements for degree completion. Program degree requirements are subject to changes on the basis of program improvement and to meet state licensure requirements. All students must adhere to the following guidelines:

Associate of General Studies Policies:

- ❖ Minimum of 60 credit hours is required.
- ❖ Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 in all coursework.
- ❖ Minimum of 15 credit hours must be taken at FHSU.

Bachelor of General Studies Policies:

- ❖ Minimum of 120 credit hours is required
- ❖ Minimum cumulative and FHSU GPA of 2.00.
- ❖ Minimum of 45 credit hours must be upper division.
- ❖ Minimum of 60 credit hours must be from a 4-year school.
- ❖ Minimum of 80 credit hours in liberal arts departments.
- ❖ Minimum of 30 credit hours must be taken at FHSU.
- ❖ Maximum of 40 credit hours from one department
